

PRIVACY POLICY

The Privacy Policy describes our policies and procedures regarding the collection, use, and disclosure of your information when you use the Service, as well as informs you about your privacy rights.

We use your Personal Data to provide and improve the Service. By using the Service, you agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

INTERPRETATION AND DEFINITIONS

Interpretation

Words capitalized herein shall have meanings as defined under the following conditions. The following definitions have the same meaning regardless of whether they are in the singular or plural form.

Definitions

- **Account** means a unique account created for you to access our Service or its parts.
- **Affiliate** means a legal entity that controls, is controlled by, or is under common control with a party, where "control" means ownership of 50% or more of the shares, equity interest, or other securities with voting rights for the election of directors or other governing bodies.
- **Company** (referred to in this Agreement as "Company," "We," "Us," or "Our") refers to [Sneq.bet](https://sneq.bet).
- **Cookies** are small files placed by a website on your computer, mobile device, or any other device that contain information about your browsing history on this website among its various uses.
- **Country** refers to Cyprus.
- **Device** means any device that can access the Service, such as a computer, mobile phone, or digital tablet.
- **Personal Data** means any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person.
- **Service** refers to the Website.
- **Service Provider** means any natural or legal person who processes data on behalf of the Company. This refers to third-party companies or individuals hired by the Company to facilitate the Service, to provide the Service on behalf of the Company, to provide services related to the Service, or to assist the Company in analyzing how the Service is used.
- **Third-party Social Media Service** refers to any website or social network website through which a User can log in or create an account to use the Service.

- **Usage Data** refers to automatically collected data generated either when using the Service or from the Service's infrastructure itself (e.g. page visit duration).
- **Website** refers to Sneg.bet, accessible from <https://snegbet.io/>
- **You** means the individual accessing or using the Service, or the company, or other legal entity on behalf of which such individual is accessing or using the Service, as applicable.

COLLECTION AND USE OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA

Types of Data Collected

■ **Personal Data**

When using our Service, we may ask you to provide certain personal information that can be used to contact or identify you. Personal information may include, but is not limited to:

- Email address
- First name and last name
- Phone number
- Usage Data

■ **Usage Data**

Usage Data is collected automatically when using the Service.

Usage Data may include information such as your device's Internet Protocol address (e.g. IP address), browser type, browser version, pages of our Service that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages, unique device identifiers, and other diagnostic data.

When you access the Service through a mobile device or by using one, we may automatically collect certain information, including but not limited to the type of mobile device you use, the unique ID of your mobile device, your mobile device's IP address, your mobile operating system, the type of mobile internet browser you use, unique device identifiers, and other diagnostic data.

We may also collect information that your browser sends whenever you visit our Service or when you access the Service by or through a mobile device.

■ **Information from Third-Party Social Networks**

The Company allows you to create an account and log in to use the Service through the following Third-Party Social Networking services:

- Google
- Telegram

If you choose to register through a third-party social networking service or otherwise grant us access to it, we may collect personal data that is already associated with your account on the third-party social network, such as your name, email address, actions, or your contact list associated with that account.

You may also have the option to share additional information with the Company through your account on a third-party social network. If you choose to provide such information and Personal Data during registration or otherwise, you grant the Company permission to use, transmit, and store them in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

■ **Tracking Technologies and Cookies**

We use cookies and similar tracking technologies to monitor actions within Our Service and store certain information. The tracking technologies used are beacons, tags, and scripts for collecting and tracking information, as well as for improving and analyzing Our Service. The technologies we use may include:

- **Browser Cookies.** A cookie is a small file placed on Your device. You can instruct Your browser to refuse all cookies or to indicate when a cookie is being sent. However, if You do not accept cookies, You may not be able to use some parts of our Service. If You do not change Your browser settings to refuse cookies, our Service may use cookies.
- **Web Beacons.** Some sections of our Service and our emails may contain small electronic files known as web beacons (also referred to as clear GIFs, pixel tags, and single-pixel GIFs) that allow the Company, for example, to count users who have visited those pages or opened an email and for other related website statistics (e.g., recording the popularity of a certain section and verifying system and server integrity).

Cookies may be "Persistent" or "Session" Cookies. Persistent Cookies remain on your personal computer or mobile device when You go offline, while Session Cookies are deleted as soon as You close your web browser.

We use both Session and Persistent Cookies for the purposes set out below:

■ **Necessary / Essential Cookies**

Type: Session Cookies

Administered by: Us

Purpose: These Cookies are essential to provide You with services available through the Website and to enable You to use some of its features. They help to authenticate users and prevent fraudulent use of user accounts. Without these Cookies, the services that You have asked for cannot be provided, and We only use these Cookies to provide You with those services.

■ **Cookies Policy / Notice Acceptance Cookies**

Type: Persistent Cookies

Administered by: Us

Purpose: These Cookies identify whether users have accepted the use of cookies on the Website.

■ **Functionality Cookies**

Type: Persistent Cookies

Administered by: Us

Purpose: These Cookies allow us to remember choices You make when You use the Website, such as remembering your login details or language preferences. The purpose of these Cookies is to provide You with a more personalized experience and to avoid You having to re-enter your preferences every time You use the Website.

Use of Your Personal Data

The Company may use Personal Data for the following purposes:

- **To provide and maintain our Service**, including monitoring the use of Our Service.
- **To manage Your Account**: To manage Your registration as a user of the Service. The Personal Data You provide can give You access to different functionalities of the Service that are available to You as a registered user.
- **To perform a contract**: To develop, fulfill, and carry out a contract for the sale of products, items, or services You have purchased, or any other contract with Us through the Service.
- **To contact You**: To contact You by email, telephone calls, SMS, or other equivalent forms of electronic communication, such as mobile application push notifications regarding updates or informative messages related to features, products, or contractual services, including security updates when necessary or reasonable for their implementation.
- **To provide You** with news, special offers, and general information about other goods, services, and events which We offer that are similar to those that You have already purchased or inquired about unless You have opted not to receive such information.
- **To manage Your requests**: To attend to and manage Your requests to Us.
- **For business transfers**: We may use Your information to evaluate or conduct a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of Our assets, whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation, or similar proceeding, in which Personal Data held by Us about users of Our Service is among the assets transferred.

- **For other purposes:** We may use Your information for other purposes, such as data analysis, identifying usage trends, determining the effectiveness of our promotional campaigns, and evaluating and improving Our Service, products, services, marketing, and Your experience.

We may disclose Your Personal Data in the following situations:

- **To service providers:** We may disclose Your Personal Data to service providers for the purpose of monitoring and analyzing the use of Our Service, and for contacting You.
- **For business transfers:** We may share or transfer Your Personal Data in connection with or during negotiations of any merger, sale of Company assets, financing, or acquisition of all or a portion of Our business by another company.
- **With Affiliates:** We may share Your information with Our affiliates, in which case We will require those affiliates to honor this Privacy Policy. Affiliates include Our parent company and any other subsidiaries, joint venture partners, or other companies that We control or that are under common control with Us.
- **With business partners:** We may share Your information with Our business partners to offer You certain products, services, or promotional offers.
- **With other users:** When You share personal information or otherwise interact in the public areas with other users, such information may be viewed by all users and may be publicly distributed outside. Similarly, other users will be able to view descriptions of Your activity, communicate with You, and view Your profile.
- **With Your consent:** We may disclose Your Personal Data for any other purpose with Your consent.

Use of Your Personal Data

The Company will retain your Personal Data only for as long as it is necessary for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy. We will retain and use your personal data to the extent necessary to fulfill our legal obligations (for example, if we are required to retain your data to comply with applicable laws), resolve disputes, and enforce our legal agreements and policies.

The Company will also retain Usage Data for internal analysis purposes. Usage Data is generally retained for a shorter period of time, except when this data is used to strengthen the security or improve the functionality of Our Service, or we are legally obligated to retain this data for longer periods.

Transfer of Your Personal Data

Your information, including Personal Data, is processed at the operational offices of the Company and in any other places where the parties involved in the processing are located. This means that this information may be transferred and stored on computers located outside of your state, province, country, or other governmental jurisdiction, where data protection laws may differ from those of your jurisdiction.

Your consent to this Privacy Policy, followed by your submission of such information, signifies your agreement to such transfer.

The Company will take all reasonably necessary steps to ensure the secure handling of your data in accordance with this Privacy Policy, and the transfer of your personal data will not be made to an organization or country unless adequate control measures, including the security of your data and other personal information, are in place.

Delete Your Personal Data

You have the right to delete or request assistance in deleting Personal Data that We have collected about you.

Our Service may provide you with the option to delete certain information about you from the Service.

You can update, modify, or delete your information at any time by logging into your account, if you have one, and visiting the account settings section that allows you to manage your personal information. You can also contact us to request access, correction, or deletion of any personal information you have provided to us.

Please note, however, that we may need to retain certain information when we have a legal obligation or legitimate basis to do so.

Disclosure of Your Personal Data

Business Operations

If the Company is involved in a merger, acquisition, or sale of assets, your Personal Data may be transferred. We will notify you before your Personal Data is transferred and becomes subject to another Privacy Policy.

If Law enforcement

Under certain circumstances, the Company may be required to disclose your Personal Data if it is required by law or in response to valid requests by government authorities (such as a court or government agency).

Other Legal Requirements

The Company may disclose your Personal Data in good faith belief that such actions are necessary to:

- Fulfill a legal obligation
- Protect and defend the rights or property of the Company
- Prevent or investigate potential violations in connection with the Service
- Safeguard the personal safety of Service users or the public
- Guard against legal liability

Security of your Personal Data

The security of your data is important to us, but remember that no method of transmission over the Internet or method of storage is 100% secure. While we expect to use commercially acceptable means to protect personal information, we do not plan to use absolute security.

CHILDREN'S PRIVACY

Our Service is not intended for individuals under 18 years of age. We do not knowingly collect personal information from individuals under 18 years of age. If you are a parent or guardian and you are aware that your child has provided us with personal information, please contact us. If we become aware that we have collected Personal Data from an individual under 18 years of age without parental consent verification, we will take steps to remove this information from our servers.

If we need to rely on consent as a legal basis for processing your information and your country requires parental consent, we may require the consent of your parent before collecting and using this information.
